

Auto Safety: Car safety belts are no joke says a Cornell University research group, Only about 1-million of 57-million cars on the highways today are fitted with the belts-because people don't sare about taking them seriously and auto dealers don't "push" them.

The fact is, says Cornell, the safety belts-offered as optional equipment by all auto companies at an average cost of 30 dollars for a twin front seat installation-could save at least 19,000 lives a year in this country, and reduce injuries by at least 50%,

"The Nonsense About Safe Driving", By J.D. Williams head of the mathematics department of the Rand Corporation brings some new conclusions to the fore about serious accidents, fatalities, automobile speeds, etc.

He states for example that the automobile kills about 100 people a day, but this conveyance still has a large credit balance in the matter of lives. For consideration, this fact, if all automotive vehicles wre ordered off the road for 24 hours doctors could not visit patients, people would not have access to hospitals fireman could not control fires, and police would be handicapped in the prevention of crime. Deaths for this day, then would rise to over 1,000 over the norma

Our traffic laws limit speed rather than promote traffic flow. Mr. Williams suggests that organizations like the National Safety Council Might well abandon their statistical death warnings in favor of more constructive programs; better methods of unsmarling traffic knots; Seat belts, shoulder harnesses and crash helmetas better signaling equipment, slowdown lights etc.
