1991 PREFERRED NUMBER PROGRAM - NATIONAL RACES ONLY

- 1. Starting November 10, 1990 and continuing until March 1, 1991, written requests for numbers will be accepted by the NEDIV Pointskeeper.
- 2. Until December 31, 1990, preference for numbers will be given to those finishing in the first ten (10) positions in their class in the 1990 season.
- From January 1, 1991, the remaining preferred numbers will be filled from the requests previosuly sent since November 10, 1990.
- 4. Classes which raced together a fair amount of times during the 1990 race season will be grouped together. Only two digit numbers are eligible.
- 5. You must provide a stamped, self-addressed envelope when you request a number in order to receive confirmation. Include three (3) choices and your race class. Please no phone requests.
- 6. Preferred numbers are given on a first come, first served basis within the two categories of finishing. Numbers do not carry over from one year to the next.

breeze to make everything comfortable. A 10 minute warmup in the morning went well, we scrubbed in a new set of tires for the race and tried to make up a little for the lost track time on Thursday. By race time the whole team is wound up tight. There's nothing more to be done on the car, we've taken all the pictures we can think of and nobody has any bright ideas on how to go faster. Except for the lack of track experience, we haven't been this ready for a race all year long.

The pace lap was a quick one and it looked to me like there was a big gap between the row I was in and the rest of the field when the green flag fell. Everyone made it through the first turn and we were off to what turned out to be a very safe race. Contrary to most of the races, there were no crashes, only 2 or 3 minor spins and only two cars were not running at the end. I ran hard but carefully. By the end of the race I was starting to feel much more comfortable about the track, but of course that was a little too late. At about 3/4 distance the engine turned into a V7. It had jumped out of first gear a couple of times and, it turned out, broke a couple of push rods. But it kept running without any signs of self-destruction so I pressed on. At the end I finished 11th, one lap down. I don't think the engine problem cost any finishing positions.

Since I didn't get a post-race interview on ESPN let me take this opportunity to thank all my sponsors: Dragonslayer, Inc., Clifton Park Engine Rebuilders, Saratoga Communications, and Hoosier Racing Tires. And a special thank you to Doug Pyle for all the time and knowledge he contributed throughout the year. Without the help of these and many more of our friends all this wouldn't have been possible.

Oh yes, the excuses: I had never driven this course before, didn't get enough track time, the front runners had over 100 horsepower more than I did, the engine let me down, and the sun got in my eyes.

When we got home Monday evening, ESPN had a summary of the Runoffs on "Motorweek Illustrated". It was a pleasent surprise to find our car on camera during one of the highlights.

It was great! A full week of fun, new friends, and lots of racing. We learned a lot, did our best and came home in one piece. Will we go back next year? You can bet on it! And next year we're going for a top five finish. Come down and join us. Thanks to all our Mo-Hud friends for your encouragement and your support.

lot of pointers, and Brech Kauffman, a long time Trans-Am driver played the role of coach throughout the week.

The rest of the crew arrived early Tuesday afternoon. My father, Paul, and Crew Chief, Jeff Gorss, drove south together, and old friend Tony LeBoutillier drove over from Tampa. They all were in time to see the second practice session. Once back on track some of the pointers I had gotten helped and I started to improve. I was still careful to not abuse the equipment but took 4 seconds off Monday's time. Two of the blind turns were still giving me fits. Turn 2, a slow left over the brow of a moderate speed climb was getting to be embarassing - I don't think I did it well all week. I'm used to seeing where I'm going!

Wednesday brought an early morning session, the first timed qualifying opportunity. I put on new left side tires and more gear in the differential. On track I found that I was starting to feel better about most of the course and improved my times another 3.5 seconds. That put us 12th on the grid. It started raining hard just as we left the pits at the end of the session-our luck is still holding. The rest of the day was spent carefully going over the car. The only thing wrong was a stripped spark plug hole. But, after a little searching I found a Helicoil kit (Les Handley, Phila.) and someone who knew how to use it (Jack Lawrence, WNY) and the crisis of the week was promptly resolved.

The second qualifying session was to be late Thursday afternoon. I had hopes of further improving my time and, perhaps, grid position. I certainly needed the additional track time. Unfortunately it began to rain about 30 minutes before our turn on track. There was nothing to be gained and a lot to lose by going on out so we watched from the pits. Only six cars did go out and three of those had to because they had missed the Wednesday gualifying session. Now we have to wait for race day. The GT-1 race is scheduled for 3:30 Sunday afternoon.

Friday and Saturday were spent watching some of the best racing I have ever seen. Really impressive, close competition in all classes. You'll see all the results and reports in "Sports Car" but NEDIV certainly made a good showing. Did anyone ever consider keeping points from each race and crowning a "Champion Division"? I think we would have won.

The GT-1 field was average size, 21, and with a broad range of capabilities. Five of the top cars were Trans-Am regulars and, if nothing else, they put us to shame on the amount of paddock space needed. There were only two cars from the northeast. The two fastest NEDIV cars, Rick Bell and Walter Payton, didn't attend. We knew our limitations and were going to be satisfied with a top half finish.

Race day was perfect weather - cloudless, 85, a slight

IT'S TRUE! - the Atlanta Runoffs is an experience every club racer should have the opportunity to enjoy. After working all season to qualify (we finished 2nd in NEDIV GT-1 points) we debated whether or not to go. We would have to go on a severly limited budget and certainly wouldn't be one of "Sports Car's" picks to win. But after a lot of encouragement from our friends we loaded everything and headed south.

The trip down, and back, was a thousand miles - twenty hours on the road - each way. Carol and I left Saratoga late Friday afternoon and arrived at the track 11am Saturday. This turned out to be our first piece of luck as we beat the rush by about an hour. By noon we were in our paddock space, unloaded, and making new friends.

Registration was a breeze. There were no lines and the registrar in the GT line turned out to be Lynn Dignan, from New England Region. It was good to start things out with a familiar face.

Our paddock space was ideal - right in the center of the upper paddock, a short walk from practically everything. The motorhome was down in the hollow by the back gate but that was fine - gave us a chance to get away (go home?) in the evenings and not live with the race car 24 hours a day.

Tech on Sunday afternoon went smoothly. Each class has an appointed time so there isn't a great free-for-all. While a couple of cars were hassled about illegal sheetmetal (they deserved it) everyone was finaly passed. I've had more difficulty at Limerock regionals.

Sunday evening Carol and I walked the track. 2.52 miles of hills and blind turns. It looked tough on foot and was going to be a real challenge at speed. On the way back to the motorhome Sunday night Carol discovered the biggest 4-leaf clover either of us had ever seen. We taped it to the dash board of the Corvette and it worked - we had virtually a trouble free week of racing.

The first practice session was late Monday morning. I took it easy, needing to learn the track without working the equipment too hard. I made only one serious mistake but avoided a spin by driving off and across country. One of the Camaros, however, went off early in the session. He hit a tire wall and rolled the car in a big way - done for the week. Seeing him on his roof through the rest of the session certainly served as a good object lesson in patience. Overall, the course is intimidating to a first time driver and I felt pretty low. After the session I went off to find someone with more experience to get some help. Larry Merrick. the NEDIV GT-1 champion had taken a driver's school at Atlanta and provided a



RUN-OFFS:

"The SCCA NARRC RunOffs" (DOUBLE POINTS) is 9/21-22/90 at Lime Rock Park. The event is open to ALL drivers who are not entered in the SCCA's National RunOffs.

CHAMPIONSHIP:

Each class champion will be decided by total points accumulated in ALL of the 1990 NARRC events. For a class champion to be declared, the class must have a minimum of two (2) starters during the season.

PRIZE MONEY:

"The SCCA NARRC RunOffs" may include Prize Money for each class with a minimum of two starters. These cash awards will be separate from the NARRC Money Fund.

MONEY FUND:

From each NARRC race, \$5.00 of each entry fee is set aside for the fund. Distribution is based on drivers' accumulated series points, number of participating cars in class, PLUS the following conditions:

- 1. the class must have a 1.5 average participation
- 2. a driver's *20* point minimum per class must be earned in more than one (1) event.

NOTE--> Both the Money Fund and Prize Money checks will be awarded at the annual NARRC banquet (details t.b.a.).

OTHER ITEMS:

Tie-breakers, points loss due to exclusions/protests, etc., will parallel the GCR rules for National events.

RULES for N.A.R.R.C. CLUB FORDS

Cars must conform to all the rules and specifications applicable to regular Formula Fords per the GCR. Otherwise, the Northeast Division Club Formula Ford rules apply - with the following exceptions:

- A 50% suspension rule is in effect; the shocks and springs for either the front or the rear must be outboard. There is no chassis model year cut-off; no backdating/updating permitted.
- 2. For their racing slicks, drivers may choose between HOOSIER 60 OR M&H #24 tire compounds; any CFF not on "spec" tires will be classified as a regular Formula Ford. Rain tires are free. [Compliance is the responsibility of the class' competitors.]
- 3. Bodywork is free, provided it conforms to the specifications for regular Formula Fords per the GCR.

1990 Series - Final Standings

FROM:

Attached are the points totals for the 1990 North Atlantic Road-Racing Championship. A copy has also been sent to the Points Fund Administrator, Patricia Gillespie.

During 1990, 631 different drivers competed in at least one series event. As indicated on the race results, 82% of those drivers were from the N.A.R.R.C. regions, with the representation apportioned as follows: New England Region, 307 drivers (48.7%); Northern New Jersey Region, 107 drivers (17.1%); New York Region, 71 drivers (11.3%); Mohawk-Hudson Region, 31 drivers (4.9%). The remaining 18% consists of drivers representing 20 different regions, with no more than 15 representatives in the series from any of those regions.

Of the 28 classes eligible for the NARRC series, 26 champions were crowned this season. No drivers were eligible for championships in either the ASR or DSR categories. Competitors from New England Region captured 18 class titles, while New York Region pilots clinched five championships (F440, F Production, GT-1, IT-S and SSA), Northern New Jersey Region drivers took two (GP & FC) and one Mohawk-Hudson member was also successful (IT-A).

At this time, I am submitting a suggestion for the 1991 N.A.R.R.C. series. In addition to the points accumulated from finishing positions, I would like to see the drivers earn one (1) point for each official start in a N.A.R.R.C. event. Several benefits come to mind if this option is approved. When the season ends, drivers would have more than a zero in the points column; this might also put a few drivers "over the top" concerning the money fund points minimum - an added incentive to try a little harder or attend an extra event. Also, using this season as an example, the starting points would have broken some of the ties and/or determined a championship in favor of the driver who participated in more events (translation: support of the series). Basically, I just feel that these starting points would give those drivers who are not quite front-runners (for a variety of reasons) a little something to show for their efforts in supporting the series.

Unfortunately I am unable to attend the Pittsburgh convention, but look forward to seeing most -if not all- of you in Baltimore (maybe) or Albany (definitely).

The stickers can say whatever they want; what works in these parts is Sports Car Racing, and that's how its going to stay when I write press releases. But it does give one pause to ponder about the perview of those running the show.
