

Tom Campbell - Second in GT1


Out of an official count of 194 entries, 26 Mo-Hud drivers took the green flag. Not too shabby.



Several people from downstate came up to play. Unfortunately, they also took home a lot of trophies and season points.





On behalf of NESEA, I would like to thank you and Mohawk-Hudson Region SCCA for support of the 1999 NESEA American Tour de Sol. I would particularly like to thank you for organizing the Autocross event in Lake George. The site was very challenging, but you really worked out a very good arrangement, and I heard many favorable comments from the competitors! Your support has made it possible for us to test the handling capabilities of these electric and hybrid vehicles, and to reach millions of people worldwide, creating greater awareness of environmentally friendly electric transportation options.

As you may know, this year, the 11th annual NESEA Tour was busting at the seams with more market-ready electric vehicles built by major car manufacturers than ever before, as well as several dozen student entries from around the country. EV reliability was demonstrated as all the vehicles that started the event reached the finish line (an unpublished first), and the first fuel cell vehicle ever to compete in an event finished with flying colors.

The event got off to a great start in Waterbury under sunny skies. Over a dozen reporters from prestigious media participated as "consumer acceptability" judges. The event was then beset with storm watches, torrential rains and mini-tornadoes in Hartford and Pittsfield, MA, which made the festivities in Albany and beyond even more special. In Albany Governor Pataki spoke and accepted a commemorative painting and over 50 legislators participated in ride and drives. Also in Albany CleanPower'99 and a hybrid vehicle conference joined with the NESEA Tour to create a great celebration of the emerging electric and hybrid vehicle industry and renewable energy technologies.

In August you will receive a newsletter reporting on the successes of the event in greater detail. In the meantime, enclosed is the final press release and results table.

Next year, NESEA is planning a New York to Washington, DC event for the millennium. In 2001 we plan to return to New England and perhaps to Lake George! Please pass my thanks onto all the club members that worked on the Autocross, and we look forward to working with you in the future when we next return to your area.

Thank you again, from all of the NESEA staff and volunteers, and the NESEA American Tour de Sol participants.


