


#### Webmaster's Report


Nothing much to report this month. Adding the requirement that one has to be registered to post to the message board seems to have stopped the spam and other off topic junk that was being posted by "bots".

# MoHud's Paul Tariello honored at Saratoga Auto Museum

May 29, 2005, Saratoga Springs, NY

The Saratoga Automobile Museum was the scene of a brief ceremony, honoring the memory of the late Paul J Tariello Jr. of Schenectady, a longtime member of MoHud region SCCA.

Paul passed away in 2003 after a long illness. He was a strong competitor, a MoHud officer and a very dedicated volunteer for our region. He has been sorely missed. To honor Paul, Mo-Hud members along with his friends and family established a memorial fund which was used to purchase a custombuilt display case for the Saratoga Automobile Museum.

The ceremony on Sunday, May 29th featured remarks by MoHuds Greg Rickes, Ron Hedger, a Saratoga Auto Museum board member and racing exhibit coordinator, and was attended by Paul's parents, Paul Sr. and



Anne as well as his sister, Lesa Hayward and her husband Clark and nieces and nephews, Lauren, Corey, and Chelsey. That particular date was selected to coincide with Paul's favorite race, the Indy 500.

Saratoga Automobile Museum has racing as one of its major components. The second floor "Racing Across New York" gallery features a variety of vintage race cars, the New York State Stock Car Association's Hall of Fame as well as a display honoring the recipients of Mo-Hud's most prestigious worker award, the Lewis Trophy.

"Paul's memory will be well served by the addition of the display case to the racing gallery," said Hedger. The Tariello memorial display case will go right alongside one of America's most famous race cars, the Murrell BelangerKurtis/Offy."

MoHud members, families and friends should make a trip to the Saratoga Auto Museum to view this very special memorial honoring one of our very own as well as view all the other auto memorabilia on display there.
