GENE TRICOZZI REPORT

I had intended to open with the completion of my report on the National Convention but because I

just got back from the NeDiv Roundtable there are more important issues to discuses.

The most important issues, in light of annual tech fast approaching, are those discussed in the Tech seminar. There are changes that will come up in tech that you may have missed in the GCR and Fastrack. To start, window safety nets "shall be equipped with a quick-release device and when released it shall fall down, thus not having to be flipped up on the roof." Some have suggested the net have a quick release both top and bottom in the event you find yourself on your roof.

For Showroom Stock, roll cages now require <u>two</u> side tubes connecting the front and rear hoops across both door openings. NASCAR-style side protection <u>or one bar bisecting another to form an 'X'</u>. Roll cage padding must be of non-resilient material. Jack Hanifan is working to have this new padding available for purchase at Tech Party. There is also a requirement for

a Helmet Medical Tag attached to the helmet as the form of medical information required for entry in an event. We hope to have these tags available at Tech. Sorry for the late notice on these changes but Tech will try hard to work with us on this and issue tech stickers with "fix by next" if possible.

As a reminder, Fuel Test Ports are required. Helmets must be SA2000 or newer and annual inspections will be good for one year (12 months). The Annual tech page of your log book will include the seatbelt expiration date so Tech can verify they have been updated when required.

The night finished with a buffet dinner at The Buffalo Transportation Pierce Arrow Museum. The facility was first rate with tons of automotive memorabilia and fine examples of the Mark as well as other significant makes that every enthusiast enjoys seeing.

As a reminder submissions to the KO should be emailed to Lisa Hanifan and the deadline is the 15th of the month.



2007 April Competition Report

First, and most importantly, there was a typo in the last issue; SA 95 helmets are **NOT** acceptable this year. I left the word **not** out last month; all helmets must be SA 2000 or newer. Only two drivers caught the error- thanks to Dave Austin and TJ for pointing it out. Remember, helmets must have a Snell SA sticker, Snell M helmets do not comply. Please read GCR section 9.4.1.c on page 88 of your GCR. I will try to have some of the compliant roll cage material available at tech.

New Classes – There will be several new classes this year, Formula 1000 which will be designated as

FB, FSCCA will be a separate class this year designated as FE. A new Improved Touring class will be ITR and we will add a new Prepared Category. B and D Prepared will be the first two classes in this category. Some IT cars may be eligible for the Prepared Category. Super Touring – ST- will be a new addition to the Touring Category.

One last note, tech inspectors will be placing an emphasis on enforcing GCR section 9.3.18.D, which can be found on page 74. Remember to bring your suit and helmet to the tech party so you can get your 2007 helmet sticker.




