

NNJR is giving us a lot of support with the Driving Impressions Pro IT race. We are trying to be as conservative as possible with our expenses.

The Chuck Wagon crew headed by **Jim Garry** and assisted by **Pete Smith** and **Eric Smith** will be working the Friday dinner at the track. They will coordinate our cookout. They will also serve lunch on Saturday. **Jim Garry** has also secured a set of **Hoosier Tires** for a raffle prize at the race.
