Activities - We are planning a go kart event at K1 Speed, Washington Ave Extension, Albany for Saturday, Jan 9th, 1:00 pm. Start time - 12:30 pm.

Competition - 2005 helmets have been extended for one more year. Jack summarized the accomplishments of a number of Mo-Hud members. Jack is working on revising the Awards/Points for the Mo-Hud driver championship.

Old Business - By laws - we need another member to assist Eric and Russ Gorman in reviewing and updating the bylaws. Last time they were updated was in the mid 1980's. Conceptual approval of suggested revisions will

be presented to the membership prior to beginning developing the new proposed language. Per the current bylaws, two thirds of the voting membership must approve proposed revisions. Tom Campbell advised that the Saratoga Museum was very appreciative of the \$1000 MoHud donation for their support of the NEDIV as well as TRSS.

New Business - None.

Greg Rickes - Did a presentation on the road races in Alexandria Bay village streets run by the Automobile Racing Club of America in the early 1930's. This was the pre cursor to SCCA. First race was in 1936.

New Opportunity for Formula F Racers

RCFFS stands for Right Coast Formula F Series, the new name for what has been known as DUFFUS since being initiated in 2013.

Right Coast is not meant to slight the Left Coast aka California etc in any way, simply to define where we are scheduling races.

RCFFS is an informal series of races for ALL FF and CF cars featuring as many stand alone as in only FF and CF races as possible to schedule.

RCFFS is NOT a points or purse paying series, but a format for safe and fun weekend race events featuring paddock camaraderie and good track time.

This lack of points gathering and score keeping certainly doesn't mean the races are any less hard

fought but it does negate the need to try to offer any real or perceived "level playing field."

Due to the emphasis on fun and not points we encourage any and all FF and CF cars and drivers to run on whatever tires each prefers, the only requirement being that CF cars must be on either hard compound slicks or treaded or shaved street radials.

The usual CF rule regarding at least one end of the car being outboard suspension is to be adhered to.

To reiterate, ALL FF and CF cars and drivers are invited to participate and both Ford Kent 1,600cc and Honda Fit 1,500cc motors restricted per current SCCA rules are allowed. Should someone choose to install a Honda motor in

their 1970 Titan Mk 6 and run the stickiest slicks available, have at it. Alternatively should someone want to install their home built Kent into a 2015 Mygale and shaved street radials, welcome aboard!

We are inclusive of any and all FF and CF cars on whatever tires the entrant prefers on the standard 5.5"X13" FF/CF rim.
